Fall Sunday School Schedule:

K-5th Sunday School will meet weekly at 10am on Sunday mornings during worship. Children will be dropped off by parents at the Woodward area of the parking lot before worship. Everyone will be required to wear masks and use hand sanitizer before taking their seats. Individual material bins will be used to minimize sharing items between children.

Youth can bring themselves to the Woodward area of the parking lot before worship. Everyone will be required to wear masks and use hand sanitizer before taking their seats. Youth Group, grades 6-12th will meet on the 3rd Sunday of the month from 4-5:30pm on the 6th floor roof of the church building starting on September 19th. Masks will be required for those who are unvaccinated and encouraged for all others. September 19th will be a Game Night.
