The SPRC will meet with Rev. Darryl Totty at 6:00 p.m. and then the Church Cluster Conference time will be at 7:00 p.m.

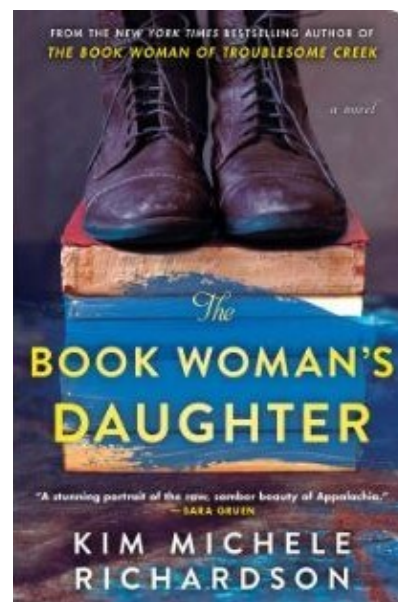
Everything will be through Zoom and the Zoom link will be emailed to you.

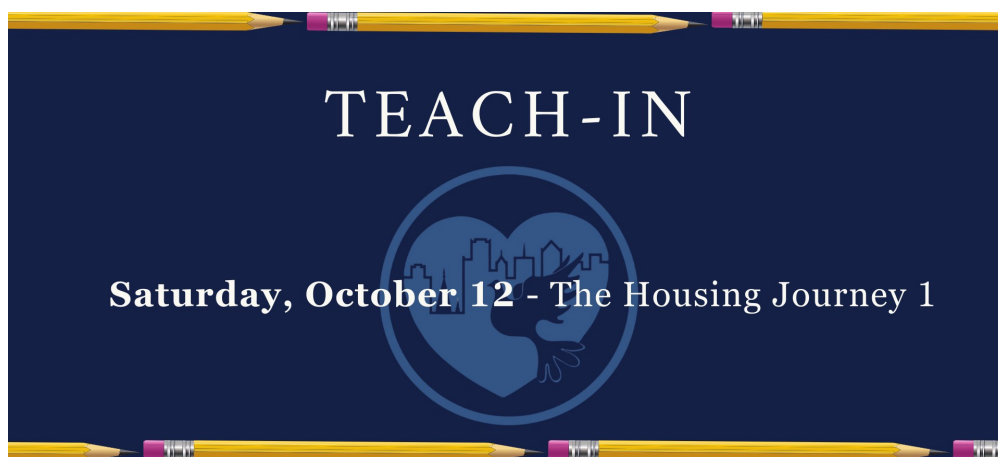
From Margaret Reese, Director of Music
