

### <u>Nursery</u>

The church nursery is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor behind the reception desk. It is currently open for use by any families who need a separate space with their littlest ones. Central UMC is in the process of finding a regular Nursery Worker to staff the nursery on Sunday mornings.

### Children & Youth Sunday School

Regular Sunday School has resumed. The K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade class will meet weekly while the Youth class will meet on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month. Both classes will be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Floor in the Clara Webb room to take advantage of the better ventilation.
