## Nursery

The church nursery is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor behind the reception desk. It is currently open for use by any families who need a separate space with their littlest ones. Central UMC is in the process of finding a regular Nursery Worker to staff the nursery on Sunday mornings.

## Children & Youth Sunday School

The K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade class meets weekly while the Youth class meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month. *Both classes are returning to their 3<sup>rd</sup> floor classrooms*. We will continue to wear masks during Sunday School. Children and youth are invited to start Sunday mornings in the sanctuary with their families and travel up to Sunday School after the Children's Message. Children in the K-5<sup>th</sup> grade class must be picked up on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor after worship by a parent or approved adult. Youth will be released after worship to join their families on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor for coffee hour.
