#### **Sunday School Information**

#### **Nursery**

The church nursery is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor behind the reception desk. It is currently open for use by any families who need a separate space with their littlest ones. Central UMC is in the process of finding a regular Nursery Worker to staff the nursery on Sunday mornings.

#### Sunday School

The K-5th Grade class meets weekly while the Youth class meets on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. Children and youth are invited to start Sunday mornings in the sanctuary with their families and travel up to the 3rd floor Sunday School rooms after the Children's Message. Children in the K-5th grade class must be picked up on the 3rd floor after worship by a parent or approved adult. Youth will be released after worship to join their families on the 2nd floor for coffee hour.

#### **Worship Activity Packs**

Children are welcome to take one of the activity packs located in the Grace Space. Within each pack is an activity and coloring page, crayons, pipe cleaners, plain paper, and worship stickers. The stickers can be placed in the bulletin for the week to mark the different parts of the service.

Meaning of Advent Greens				
	<b>CEDAR:</b> It has aromatic wood and flat, soft needles. Also called <i>Arborvitae</i> , "the tree of life," it has also been known as the tree of royalty, power and longevity.			
dreamraine	<b>PINE AND FIR:</b> These evergreen needles are signs of hope and life amidst the darkness. Pine and fir also represent growth and youthful energy.			
	<b>HOLLY:</b> Holly symbolizes Christ's passion and death because of the thorny leaves and the triumph of life because it is evergreen. The red berries represent "flesh and blood," as in "the Word became flesh."			
	<b>IVY:</b> English Ivy, a vine with "evergreen" leaves, symbolizes hope, life and Christ's resurrection.
