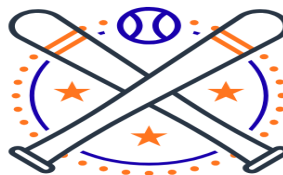
“Pedal to Provide” fights food insecurity by raising funds through their annual noncompetitive 2, 6 or 12-mile run, walk or ride.
